

Dear Friends,

I grew up in a family of photographers. My father was a dedicated amateur, and my mother went camera crazy when the grandkids came along. One of my sisters is a retired photographer, and her husband still shoots for the Chicago Tribune. I spent a lot of time around cameras and camera talk.

Technology is amazing. You can take the same camera and get two totally different views just by using two different lenses. For example, when you put on the wide-angle lens, you can get a picture that gives you a more panoramic viewpoint. Or you can change to a telephoto lens and single out the eye of an eagle one hundred yards away. A close-up lens may help you capture the veins on the underside of a mushroom. It's amazing to see how changing lenses can allow a camera can go from the big picture to the smallest details.

Jesus says in Matthew 6:9-11, "This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread.'" This is an excerpt from the Lord's Prayer, and it is really like a camera with two lenses looking at our heavenly Father. Think about the word father and what that means to you. You might have had a bad father experience growing up. When we think about God being our Father, we are thinking about the perfect father.

Look at God with the wide-angle lens focused on Him. He is in heaven, and His name is to be revered, hallowed, and revered. We should be driven to our knees by who He is. He is the God who rules a hundred billion galaxies, and when we pray, we are in the throne room from which it is all governed. Prayer should never again be boring, wimpy, or trivial when we know Whom we are with.

The Lord's Prayer says, "Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." Here is God's agenda on earth, His whole cosmic agenda, and the prayer is, "Lord, help me plug into Your cosmic agenda with my life. Your will that is done so awesomely in heaven, I want to do it on earth." We should pray with a sense of the bigness and the awesomeness of God. Then all of a sudden the Lord's Prayer switches lenses. "Give us today our daily bread." Jesus is telling us that we can come to this awesome
